We will learn about road safety and make rules to help keep ourselves and others safe. During circle time we will share our experiences of journeys. Links will also be made to our texts in Literacy.



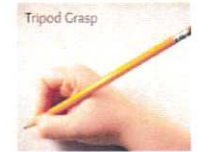
### COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

### LITERACY

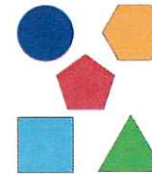

### EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

As part of our topic we will design and make vehicles using various construction materials. We will act out events from stories used in Literacy and also dance to music which links to these texts.

### MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will learn to recognise numerals and count objects to at least 10. We will begin to name and describe 2D shapes and also develop our use of different mathematical vocabulary.
