

## MATHS

In Maths, we will be following the Maths - No Problem! Scheme of work. The sequence of lessons this term will be as follows: place value, ordering numbers to 1000, counting in fifties, number patterns, counting in fours and eights, addition, subtraction, measuring length in centimetres, meters and kilometres and word problems involving length.



## ENGLISH

Some of our English lessons will focus on punctuation, spelling and grammar and we will build up these skills throughout the year. Our other English lessons will work around a book. The first book we will focus on will be 'Peter Pan' by J.M Barrie followed by 'The Mousehole Cat' by Antonia Barber. Some of the skills we will be working on include building varied and rich vocabulary in our writing, writing for different audiences, writing for different types of stories and reading our stories aloud.



## Design Technology

We will design, make and evaluate a product linking to our topic. The children will be deciding on their Design and Technology project within the first half term.



## COOKING

We will prepare and cook scones using a range of cooking techniques.



## French

This half term we will be learning how to count to ten.

## PE

We will be developing flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through gymnastics. We will also be practising the skills of attacking and invading through invasion games.

## GEOGRAPHY

During this half term, we will be making and sharing a short screencast presentation.



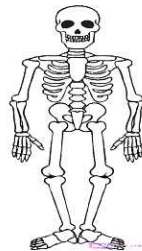
## SCIENCE
