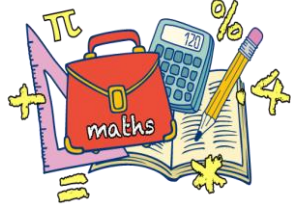


## MATHS

In Maths, we will be following the Maths - No Problem! Scheme of work. The sequence of lessons this term will be as follows:

We will continue to revise addition and subtraction techniques throughout the half term.

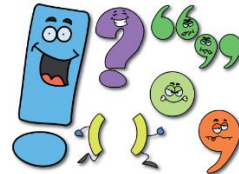


## ENGLISH

We will be using film clips to produce newspaper articles, letters and adventure stories and studying *The Witches* by Roald Dahl to learn to write in the style of a significant author

In addition, we will continue to look at the following areas of grammar:

- fronted adverbials
- inverted commas
- apostrophes
- pronouns
- paragraphs



## COMPUTING

We will continue to use the internet to research different topic areas, collecting and presenting information using word.

We will learn how to develop a simple educational game. We will design, write and debug programs, using sequences and repetition.



## GEOGRAPHY

We will be locating mountains, describing the key aspects including: climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts and the water cycle. We will also be looking at settlements in the mountains

## PE

This term Year 4 will be looking at developing flexibility, strength and techniques in gymnastics. We will also be taking part in orienteering challenges outside.

## ART & DESIGN

In art we will be using paint to mix colours and selecting and constructing textured surfaces. We will look at and create artwork in the style of Georgia O'Keefe.

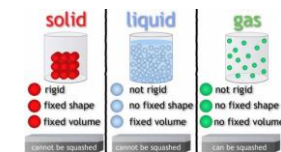
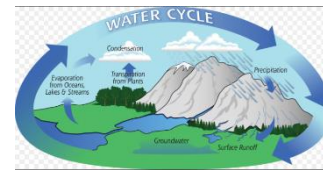


## MUSIC

In music we will be playing instruments with increasing accuracy, using and understanding musical notation and appreciating music from different composers.

## SCIENCE

This term we will compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. We will observe materials changing state when they are heated or cooled, and measure and research the temperature at which this happens. We will look at the water cycle, and identify the parts played by evaporation and condensation.



## RE/PSHCE

This half term we will be studying Hinduism, looking at inspirational people. In PSHCE we will be thinking about health and well-being, thinking about keeping safe, where to get help and responsibilities for keeping ourselves and others safe.

## FRENCH

In French this half term we will look at zoo animals, asking for French translation, and revision of adjectives.

## DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

In design we will be designing and creating a mountain animal, using different materials and tools. We will evaluate our work suggesting changes when it is complete. We will learn how to use various tools correctly and safely and how to select the right tool for a given task.
