

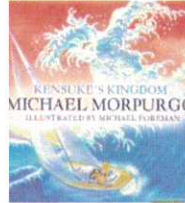
MATHS

In Maths, we will be following the Maths - No Problem! Scheme of work. The sequence of lessons this half term will be as follows: place value, reading and comparing numbers to 1 000 000, addition and subtraction.



ENGLISH

Some of our English lessons will focus on punctuation, spelling and grammar and we will build up these skills throughout the year. Our other English lessons will work around a book. The first book we will focus on is 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be focusing on narratives, diaries, recounts and information texts in these lessons.



Design Technology

We will design, make and evaluate a model of a river using paper mache. We will use this as our focus for our Geography lessons.

PE

This term we will be developing flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through gymnastics. We will also be practising the skills of attacking and invading through invasion games.

French

This term we will revise days of the week, months of the year and numbers 0 - 50. We will also look at asking for items you may find in the High Street.

COMPUTING

We will be creating our own website for cyber safety and we will develop an interactive game.

GEOGRAPHY
