

MATHS

In Maths, we will be following the Maths - No Problem! scheme of work. The sequence of lessons this term will be as follows: numbers to 10 million and all four operations on whole number. Fast Math will focus on developing basic skills in order to solve problems.

ENGLISH



During the first half term we will be reading and doing writing based on Goodnight Mister Tom. We will be writing poetry, newspaper reports, letters, diary entries and stories with historical settings. The work will link closely to what we learn during History lessons.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

In DT, we will be designing and creating a moving wartime vehicle. We will be studying the mechanisms needed in order for the vehicles to become moveable. The designs and end products will be analysed in order to support future projects.

SCIENCE

In Science, we will be learning about how light travels and how light enables us to see things. We will also be learning about why shadows have the same shape as the objects that pass them. We will have a strong focus on what makes a fair test and how to record our findings scientifically.



PE

In PE, we will be learning a number of gymnastics skills including balance, flexibility and strength.

We will also be developing our skills needed to compete in invasion games, such as running, jumping, throwing and catching.



MUSIC

In Music, we will be playing and performing in solo and ensemble contexts. They will be using their voices and musical instruments with increasing accuracy, control and expression.



RE

In RE, the theme for this term is 'Beliefs and Questions' within Christianity.

Wartime Autumn Term 1

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, we will be locating the world's countries using maps. Our focus will be on Europe, concentrating on environmental regions, physical and human characteristics, countries and major cities.

We will be making links to our learning in history and looking at the countries that formed the allied forces and areas of Europe affected by the war.



HISTORY

In History, we will be learning about the events of World War I and World War II.

We will be focusing on life in the trenches; key women involved in the war; the roles of animals on the front line; what life was like as an evacuee and the events of the 'Christmas Truce' as well as the Battle of Britain.



FRENCH

In French, we will be learning the language of the classroom as well as beginning to answer the register in French.



ART & DESIGN

In Art and Design, we will making detailed, analytical, observational drawings of various objects, using selected media. We will respond to portraits from different styles and times.



COMPUTING

In Computing, we will be creating a short television advert as part of our School Learning Council campaigns. Children will work as a team to plan, film and produce the advert to show to others.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be focusing on how to develop and keep healthy relationships with others; how actions and behaviour can affect relationships; understanding and respecting boundaries and working together to develop conflict negotiation.
